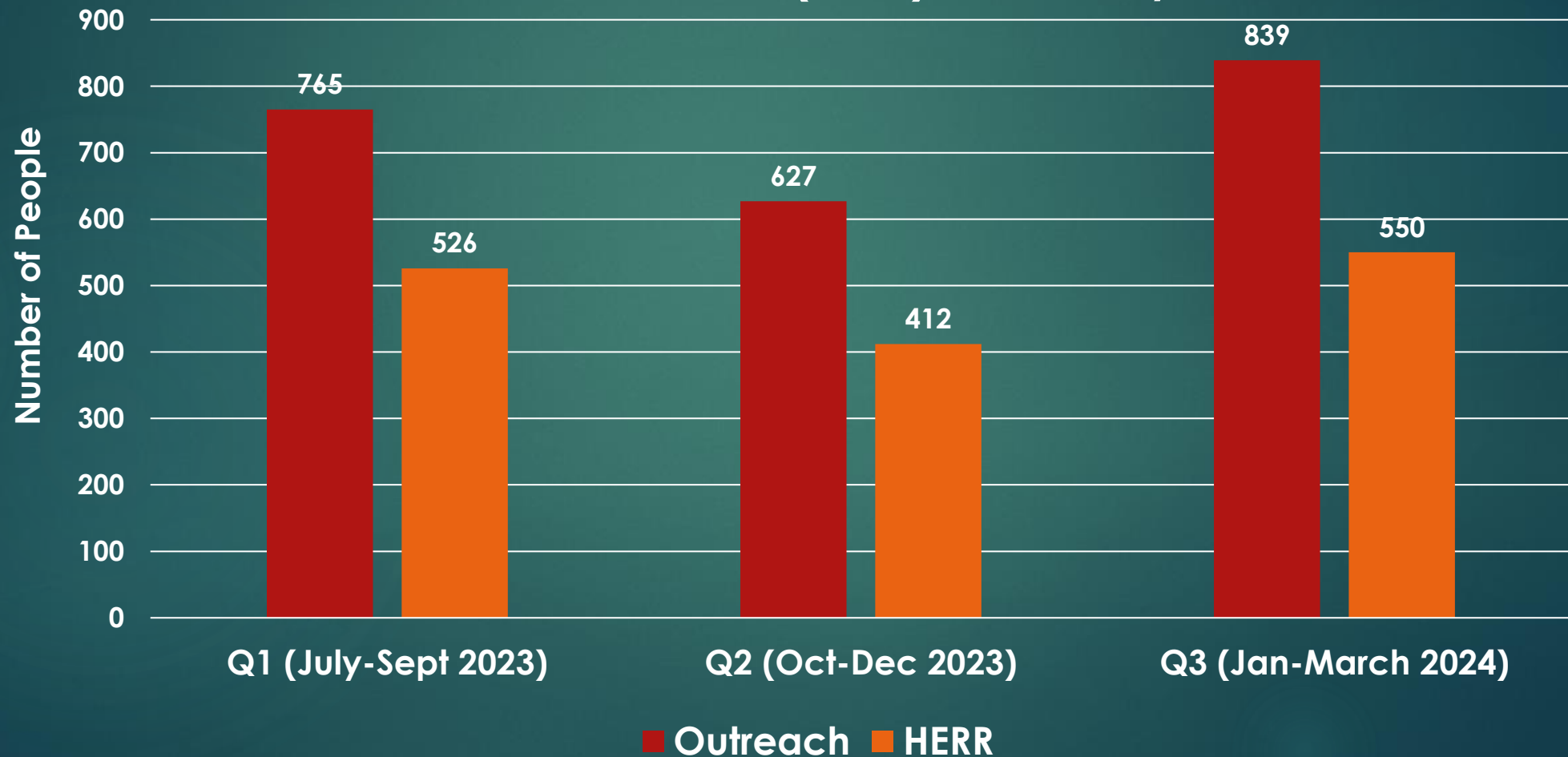
# MAI Program Approach

Number of People Receiving Outreach and Health Education/Risk Reduction (HERR) Services by Quarter

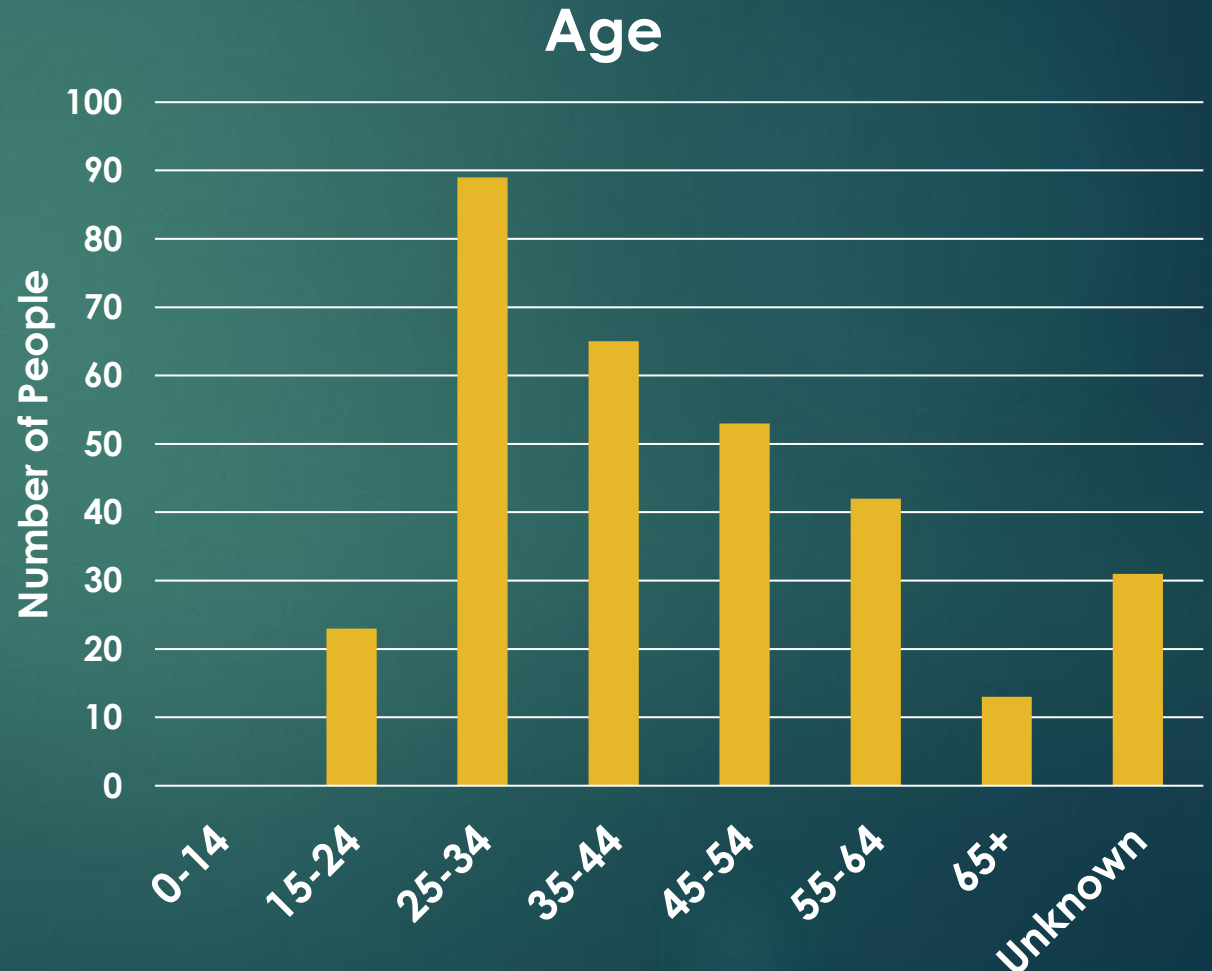
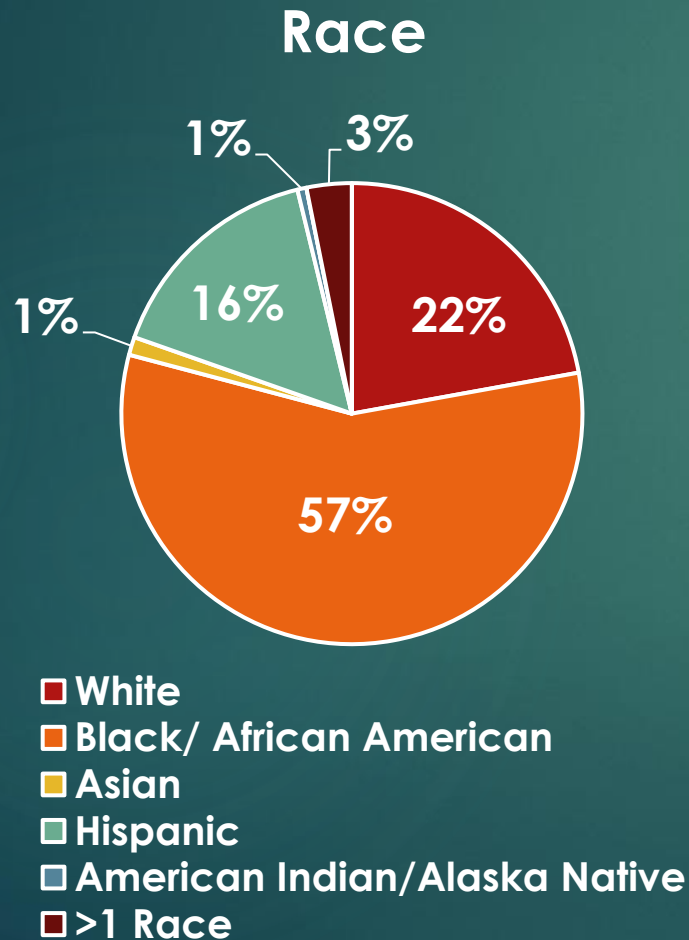


# 2023–2024 Contract Year Data

- ▶ 316 individuals newly enrolled in MAI program
- ▶ 265 individuals have been connected to HIV care (i.e., attended their first HIV medical appt. since enrollment)
- ▶ 90 individuals enrolled in SPBP
